Things to see and do in Padstow and Port Isaac

In Padstow:

- Hire a bike and cycle the Camel Trail.
- Visit the Elizabethan manor of Prideaux Place.
- Eat <u>Rick Stein's fish and chips</u>, the Michelin starred <u>Paul</u> <u>Ainsworth at No. 6</u> or have a pasty on the harbour wall (look out for the seagulls).
- Visit the <u>National Lobster Hatchery</u>.
- Catch the ferry to Rock for fine dining with <u>Nathan Outlaw</u> or a walk around the sand dunes of Daymer Bay and beautiful <u>St</u> <u>Enodoc church</u>, where Sir John Betjeman is buried.
- Enjoy the rugged scenery of the <u>coastal path to Harlyn Bay</u>.

In Port Isaac:

- See the picturesque Cornish village which was the backdrop Poldark, Doc Martin and the film Saving Grace.
- Follow the coastal path east to the Rumps (a good place to see dolphins, seals, porpoises and basking sharks) or west to Port Quin.
- Catch an outdoor performance by the shanty singers <u>Fishermen's Friends</u> on the Platt in the Summer.

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
